

Documenting Conservation Priorities on the Limestone Tributaries of the Saint John River, New Brunswick



A report to the New Brunswick Wildlife Trust Fund

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BACKGROUND AND PROJECT RATIONALE

River valleys are especially diverse portions of any landscape because of their wide range of moisture, exposure and disturbance regimes. In highly altered landscapes, they can also often retain the most natural communities because of difficulties inherent in farming and settling their steep slopes and flood-prone bottomlands.

Due to underlying calcareous sedimentary bedrock (Fyffe and Richard 2007), the rich watersheds of western Carleton and Victoria counties support an exceptionally high diversity of provincially rare vascular plants (MacDougall 1997; MacDougall and Loo 1998; Hinds 2000, AC CDC 2015) including many Appalachian hardwood forest species that reach their northern and eastern range limits in western New Brunswick, as well as many wetland species associated with high-pH Eastern White Cedar swamps, fens and other wetland types. The Meduxnekeag River valley in particular supports many of the best remaining examples of undisturbed Appalachian hardwood forest in the Maritimes.

Because rich calcareous soils tend to be especially suitable for agriculture, a high proportion of rich Appalachian hardwood forest communities in the study region have been lost to human uses. Most extant occurrences in the province consist of small remnants situated within highly fragmented agricultural landscapes. Land ownership in western Carleton and Victoria counties is predominantly private, with very little Crown land that can contribute to the provincial protected area network. Forest harvesting and forest conversion for agriculture represent significant ongoing threats. Non-governmental efforts are thus crucial to the conservation of remaining examples of the rare species-rich and provincially significant plant communities in this region.

Over the past 15 years, the Meduxnekeag River Association (MRA) and Nature Conservancy of Canada (NCC) have worked together to develop an outstanding Nature Preserve network along the Meduxnekeag River, with efforts recently expanding to other parts of the Meduxnekeag watershed. NCC's revised conservation plan for the area also aims to expand efforts to other watersheds. These organizations rely on available rare species and ecological community data to guide future land acquisitions, but data on ecological values at the scale of individual properties is often limited, making the prioritization of conservation action more difficult. With this in mind, the AC CDC has formed a close partnership with the MRA and NCC to conduct field surveys in the region that precisely document rare species occurrences and identify high-priority sites for conservation.

With project funding from the New Brunswick Wildlife Trust Fund (WTF), the AC CDC expanded on previous fieldwork carried out in 2013 and 2014, conducting biological inventories along three tributaries of the Saint John River: the Aroostook River in Victoria County, Big Presque Isle Stream in Carleton County and the Meduxnekeag River in Carleton County (Figure 1).

METHODS


Prior to fieldwork, relatively intact sites potentially supporting rare upland, wetland and shoreline plant communities were identified along three river valleys using aerial photography, used in combination with AC CDC rare species data to ensure that sites had not previously been extensively covered.

From July 2nd to 10th 2015, Sean Blaney (AC CDC Executive Director/Senior Scientist), David Mazerolle (AC CDC Botanist) and Alain Belliveau (AC CDC Botanist) devoted 16 person days (roughly 27 work days if including overtime) to surveys focused on documenting provincially rare plants and ecological communities. Figure 1 shows the location of the surveyed sites, situated in the valleys of the Aroostook River, Big Presque Isle Stream and the Meduxnekeag River. Each of these three eastern-flowing tributaries of the Saint John River originate in northeastern Maine and are at least partially underlain by limestone (Fyffe and Richard 2007). Three person days were spent surveying the Aroostook River valley including Limestone Stream (July 8th), three were spent surveying the Big Presque Isle Stream valley (July 7th) and ten were devoted to surveys on the Meduxnekeag River (July 2nd, 3rd, 9th and 10th).

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


Figure 2. Survey coverage along the Aroostook River and Limestone Stream, Victoria County, NB. Colored lines represent track files logged by GPS units during survey (red line = C.S. Blaney, blue line = D.M. Mazerolle, green line = A.G. Belliveau).

During fieldwork, botanists focused on areas with some potential to contain rich upland hardwood forests, calcareous bottomlands and high-pH river shores (limestone outcrops, seepy cobble shores, etc.), but generally made efforts to cover a sample of all habitat types found within a surveyed area. Each botanist recorded a GPS track log throughout survey coverage and these are mapped below in Figures 2 to 5. We compiled full vascular plant species lists for each site, assigning general descriptions of species' abundance within a surveyed area as follows: rare present in small numbers at very few locations; uncommon - present at roughly four or five locations in small numbers or one or two locations in large numbers; locally common - present at several locations in larger numbers but not widespread; fairly common - widespread at the site but generally not in very large numbers; common - widespread at the site and present in large numbers. For any provincially rare species encountered during surveys (those species with provincial status ranks [S-ranks], of S1 to S3S4 and/or provincial General Status Ranks of At Risk, May Be At Risk or Sensitive; see appendices 1 and 2 for rank definitions), we recorded precise locations by GPS (accurate to 10 m or less), along with information on population size and extent, habitat and associated species. Any individuals or patches separated from others by a distance of 10 m or more were generally considered distinct locations and recorded separately. A majority of rare species occurrences were also documented by voucher specimens that will be deposited at the New Brunswick Museum in Saint John, with duplicates to the Connell Memorial Herbarium at the University of New Brunswick in Fredericton and the Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada Collection of Vascular Plants in Ottawa.

In addition to vascular plant data, incidental observations for rare or COSEWIC (Committee on the Status of Endangered Wildlife in Canada)-listed animals were recorded whenever these species were detected. Observations of non-rare birds were also recorded, with breeding evidence recorded using the methods of the Maritimes Breeding Bird Atlas (http://www.mba-aom.ca).

All species occurrence data has been compiled and will be permanently documented and maintained in the Atlantic Canada Conservation Data Centre database.





Figure 4. Survey coverage along the upper Meduxnekeag River (US border to Belleville), Carleton County, NB. Colored lines represent track files logged by GPS units during survey (red line = C.S. Blaney, blue line = D.M. Mazerolle, green line = A.G. Belliveau).

RESULTS

Vascular Plant Species Richness

Across all surveyed sites, we documented nearly 5,500 vascular plant records of approximately 740 different taxa, 76% of which are native to New Brunswick and 24% of which are exotic. Statistics summarizing plant diversity at each site are compiled in the "Site Summaries" section below.

Native species richness averaged 390 across all three river valleys surveyed and ranged from 326 along Big Presque Isle Stream to 488 along the Meduxnekeag River. The proportion of exotic species by site was relatively consistent, varying from 23% along the Aroostook and Meduxnekeag rivers to 28% along Big Presque Isle Stream, and averaging 25%.

Although it provides a general indication of a site's habitat diversity and richness, native species counts are not a robust indicator of site condition or relative conservation value. Likewise, exotic species counts do not always provide an accurate inverse measure of a site's ecological integrity. Both metrics are influenced by search effort, survey coverage, and the extent to which anthropogenic habitats were traversed. Highest native and total species richness were documented along the Meduxnekeag River, which received 63% of the total survey effort carried out through this project.

A full list of all vascular plants documented through this project, with on-site abundance, is provided in Appendix 3.

Rare Vascular Plant Species

We discovered populations of 68 provincially rare vascular plant species, including 14 critically imperiled species (S1 and S1S2), 22 imperiled species (S2 and S2S3) and 32 vulnerable species (S3 and S3S4). The most important finds made through this project were the discovery of two species not previously known to be present in New Brunswick: Eastern Woodland Sedge (Carex blanda) and Prickly Gooseberry (Ribes cynosbati), both of which were found in the understory of remnant mature forest on the lower Meduxnekeag River at Woodstock. Both of these are widespread eastern North American species, are known from Maine and southern Quebec, and occur in New Brunswick at the northeastern limit of their global range. Other notable finds include the second documented population of Yellow-fruited Sedge (Carex annectens) in New Brunswick and the third documented population of Mucronate Blue-eyed-grass (Sisyrinchium mucronatum), both found along the shores of the lower Meduxnekeag River between Plymouth and Woodstock. In Canada, Yellow-fruited Sedge is known to occur from southern Ontario to Prince Edward Island and is considered imperiled to critically imperiled in all provinces. Prior to this project, its known provincial distribution was limited to a single site near Saint-Henry-de-Barachois in Westmorland County. Mucronate Blue-eyed-grass is a small plant of the Iris family that occurs along the Atlantic Coastal Plain and inland to the Great Lakes Region, Manitoba and North Dakota. This species, which is rare in northern Maine and apparently absent from Quebec, had previously been documented in New Brunswick from the St. Francis River in Madawaska County and the upper Meduxnekeag River near Jackson Falls. Both of these

populations were discovered through AC CDC fieldwork funded by the New Brunswick Wildlife Trust Fund.




Figure 6. Rare vascular plant species locations documented during survey along the Aroostook River and Limestone Stream, Victoria County, NB. Orange dots = imperiled species (S2 and S2S3), yellow dots = vulnerable species (S3 and S3S4) and grey dots = possible but unconfirmed rare species.

We documented 878 rare plant locations, with 148 locations of critically imperiled species, 284 locations of imperiled species and 446 locations of vulnerable species (see Figures 6 to 9). These occurrences represent 92 species by survey site combinations. Numbers presented here only reflect occurrences for which we were able to provide a confident identification; specimens from an additional 34 locations were identified as probable or potential rare species occurrences. Expert review of some difficult specimens will likely result in the documentation of additional rare species occurrences at our survey sites and may slightly increase the total number of rare species discovered through this project. Of particular note are specimens that have been identified as potentially being Georgia Bulrush (*Scirpus georgianus*; not presently known to occur in NB), Appalachian Sedge (*Carex appalachica*; S1, May Be At Risk) and Woolgrass Bulrush (*Scirpus atrovirens*, S1, May Be At Risk). The rare species documented through this project, with provincial status ranks and on-site abundance, are compiled in Tables 1 and 2.

Rare species richness was found to be highest in the Meduxnekeag River valley, where 54 species were detected, including 13 critically imperiled species and 14 imperiled species. Numbers of detected rare species were significantly lower along the Aroostook River and Big Presque Isle Stream, with 22 and 17 species respectively. Documented rare species richness is to some extent biased by search effort and area of survey coverage, which were significantly greater along the Meduxnekeag River. Despite this bias, the results of this project and previous efforts carried out by the AC CDC and other botanists clearly demonstrate that the Meduxnekeag River valley holds one of New Brunswick's greatest assemblages of rare species as well as the province's most significant examples of remnant rich Appalachian hardwood forest communities.

Parcels of High Conservation Value

Our fieldwork identified 26 parcels of land supporting five or more provincially rare vascular plant species and eight properties supporting over ten rare species. These parcels of land which represent areas of especially high conservation value are highlighted below in Table 2.

Animals

We documented 420 incidental observations of 75 bird species. These included 21 site location records for the COSEWIC-listed Wood Thrush (*Hylocichla mustelina*, S1S2B, Threatened), Chimney Swift (*Chaetura pelagica*, S2S3B, Threatened), Barn Swallow (*Hirundo rustica*, S3B, Threatened), Canada Warbler (*Wilsonia canadensis*, S3S4B, Threatened) and Bobolink (*Dolichonyx oryzivorus*, S3S4B, Special Concern), and 36 location records for 12 other provincially rare breeding bird species. Rare bird observations are compiled in Table 3.

SITE SUMMARIES

Aroostook River (including Limestone Stream)

Notable Features:

- Limestone outcrops are common along the river and especially extensive just below the Tinker Dam and roughly 2 km further downstream. These bedrock exposures, which are mainly dry but occasionally receive some seepage from steep valley slopes, support several rare communities. Most provincially rare plant species documented at this survey site were found in these habitats.
- The steep valley slopes above the river support many healthy stands of mature and old late-successional forest composed of Eastern Hemlock (*Tsuga canadensis*), Eastern White Cedar (*Thuja occidentalis*), Eastern White Pine (*Pinus strobus*), Sugar Maple (*Acer saccharum*) and Yellow Birch (*Betula alleghaniensis*).
- The river's floodplain is generally narrow due to steep valley slopes, but contains several rich terraces scattered between the Tinker Dam and the Highway 2 bridge. These areas support forested or partially forested floodplain communities dominated by Balsam Poplar (*Populus balsamifera*), Black Ash (*Fraxinus nigra*) and Eastern White Cedar.
- The forest near Limestone Stream has been highly disturbed by wood harvesting but the valley bottom in the upstream section supports some occurrences of mature Eastern White Cedar and Eastern White Cedar / Black Ash / Balsam Poplar floodplain forest. Away from the stream, mature Sugar Maple / American Beech forest occurred as small remnants within a landscape of recent clearcuts and agriculture.
- Limestone outcropping was absent on the upstream portion of Limestone Stream. Just upstream of the Aroostook River, Limestone Stream flows through an abrupt exposed bedrock ravine which contains several picturesque falls Outcrops around the spectacular Four Falls area. did not support any rare plants.

Big Presque Isle Stream

Notable Features:

- The large hill located due north of Barrett Lake on the south side of the stream holds an extensive area of relatively undisturbed mature hardwood forest which contains stands of rich Sugar Maple (*Acer saccharum*) / White Ash (*Fraxinus americana*) and White Ash / Sugar Maple / American Beech (*Fagus grandifolia*) / Butternut (*Juglans cinerea*, S1, COSEWIC Endangered) forest. Appalachian hardwood forest in this area supports many provincially rare understory species including the critically imperiled Nodding Fescue (*Festuca subverticillata*, S1, May Be At Risk) and Spreading Wild-rye (*Elymus hystrix* var. *bigeloviana*, S1, May Be At Risk).
- The southern valley slope roughly 1 km downstream of the Tracey Mills bridge contains a few remnant stands of mature to old Sugar Maple / Yellow Birch / American Beech forest, as well as old growth Eastern Hemlock (*Tsuga canadensis*) forest. A few rich areas with localized groundwater seepage support rare understory communities.
- The surveyed area immediately downstream of Centreville is highly disturbed and remaining forest along this section is mainly early-successional. Mature forest communities in this section are mostly limited to riparian areas, which contain several small occurrences of mature Balsam Poplar (*Populus balsamifera*) / Black Ash (*Fraxinus nigra*) / Meadow Willow (*Salix petiolaris*) floodplain forest. Floodplain plant communities along much of the stream are highly influenced by exotic species, especially in open meadow communities where the invasive Reed Canary Grass (*Phalaris arundinacea*) is generally highly dominant.
- Small limestone outcrops are scattered in upper and lower portions of the survey area, providing habitat for several provincially rare calciphylic species. The limestone outcrops are much less diverse in rare species than similar outcrops on the Saint John and Meduxnekeag Rivers.
- Steep valley slopes along the stream's lower section hold mature and old growth stands of Eastern Hemlock (*Tsuga canadensis*) and Eastern White Cedar (*Thuja occidentalis*) forest. In one such forest stand, a large Eastern Hemlock tree was cored and determined to be 224 years old. A few old stands of upland and floodplain Sugar Maple / Yellow Birch (*Betula alleghaniensis*) were also observed.

Meduxnekeag River

Notable Features:

- The Meduxnekeag River valley holds the most significant concentration of remnant rich mature Appalachian hardwood forest in New Brunswick, as well as one of the province's most significant concentrations of rare vascular plant species. The area supports provincially unique upland and wetland calciphilic plant communities, including at least four extremely rare species which are at the northeastern limit of their global range and are known from nowhere else in the province (Appalachian Sedge [*Carex appalachica*], Eastern Woodland Sedge [*Carex blanda*], Prickly Gooseberry [*Ribes cynosbati*] and Loose-flowered Sedge [*Carex laxiflora*]).
- The Meduxnekeag River watershed still holds an abundance of mature and old • late-successional forest, most of which is concentrated on valley slopes and adjacent plateaus. The valley contains a variety of hardwood, mixedwood and coniferous forest communities, all common in roughly equal measure. Coniferous and mixedwood stands are predominantly composed of Eastern Hemlock (Tsuga canadensis), Eastern White Cedar (Thuja occidentalis), Yellow Birch (Betula alleghaniensis), Sugar Maple (Acer saccharum) and Eastern White Pine (Pinus strobus). Mature tolerant hardwoods are largely dominated by Sugar Maple, Yellow Birch, White Ash (Fraxinus americana) and American Beech (Fagus grandifolia) with small components of Eastern Hemlock and Eastern White Cedar. Scattered pockets of very rich Appalachian hardwoods are characterized by Sugar Maple, White Ash, Yellow Birch, Basswood (*Tilia americana*), Ironwood (Ostrya virginiana), Black Ash (Fraxinus nigra) and Butternut (Juglans cinerea, S1, At Risk, COSEWIC Endangered). These rich forest stands, which are often influenced by calcareous groundwater seepage, support a variety of rare understory plant species and communities. The river valley also contains extensive open floodplain meadows and occurrences of mature floodplain forest dominated by Black Ash, Sugar Maple, Balsam Poplar (*Populus balsamifera*) and Eastern White Cedar.
- Limestone bedrock exposures are common along most of the river's Canadian section and are especially extensive at Jackson Falls. These habitats support various calciphilic plant communities, including numerous species of conservation concern.
- Seepy high-pH cobble river shores are common in the Jackson Falls area and sparsely scattered further downstream. The wet calcareous conditions in these habitats support fen-like communities containing numerous provincially rare species, including large populations of the critically imperiled Sterile Sedge (*Carex sterilis*, S1 - May Be At Risk; known from only one other area of New Brunswick),

and Great Northern Aster (*Canadanthus modestus*, S1 – May Be At Risk; otherwise known in New Brunswick only from the Restigouche River).

- Some of the best rich Appalachian hardwood forest communities in the MRA's Bell Forest Preserve were found to have incipient invasions of Garlic Mustard (*Alliaria petiolata*), for which control efforts might still be valuable.
- Much of the most spectacular rich Appalachian hardwood forest on the south side of the river in the Plymouth area, supporting the province's largest occurrence of Canada Violet (*Viola canadensis*, S1S2 May Be At Risk) and many other rare species, has been recently clearcut with additional cut blocks marked.

Sterile Sedge on seepy calcareous cobble shore near Jackson Falls. Mature mixedwood and hardwood forest between US border and Jackson Falls. Old growth Eastern Hemlock (*Tsuga canadensis*) forest near Jackson Falls. Long-leaved Pondweed (*Potamogeton nodosus*, S1, May Be At Risk) between US border and Jackson Falls.




Figure 8. Rare vascular plant species locations documented during survey along the upper Meduxnekeag River (US border to Belleville), Carleton County, NB. Red dots = critically imperiled species (S1 and S1S2), orange dots = imperiled species (S2 and S2S3), yellow dots = vulnerable species (S3 and S3S4) and grey dots = possible but unconfirmed rare species.




Figure 9. Rare vascular plant species locations documented during survey along the lower Meduxnekeag River (Belleville to Woodstock), Carleton County, NB. Red dots = critically imperiled species (S1 and S1S2), orange dots = imperiled species (S2 and S2S3), yellow dots = vulnerable species (S3 and S3S4) and grey dots = possible but unconfirmed rare species.

PROJECT CONTRIBUTIONS

This project, along with similar NCC- and WTF-funded AC CDC fieldwork in 2013 and 2014, has significantly improved our understanding of the present status and distribution of intact Appalachian hardwood forest communities of conservation concern. The project was highly successful in identifying parcels of land that should be considered priorities for conservation action by the Meduxnekeag River Association, the NCC, the Nature Trust of New Brunswick and the provincial government. We documented rare species on roughly 135 properties, and found 26 properties which support at least five rare species and eight properties which support more than ten rare species. The data collected and compiled through this project identifies the most significant sites for land conservation within surveyed areas, and does so at a very fine scale.

On a provincial scale, the significant amount of species occurrence data collected through this project will help refine species' ranks and inform land use decisions related to those species' habitats throughout New Brunswick, allowing scarce conservation resources to be focused where they are most needed. All data collected has been permanently documented via incorporation into the AC CDC's GIS-linked database, where it will be maintained and will be provided in response to any area- or species-specific conservation data request.

May Be At Risk	Species that may be at risk of extirpation or extinction and are therefore candidates for a detailed risk assessment by COSEWIC, or provincial or territorial equivalents.
Sensitive	Species that are not believed to be at risk of immediate extirpation or extinction but may require special attention or protection to prevent them from becoming at risk.
Secure	Species that are not believed to belong in the categories Extinct, Extirpated, At Risk, May Be At Risk, Sensitive, Accidental or Exotic. This category includes some species that show a trend of decline in numbers in Canada but remain relatively widespread or abundant.
